AMROHA EDUCATION FOUNDATION (Regd.) is a popular and eminent educational & social organization (NGO) of Amroha (U.P.). It was founded on 30th June 2000. The contribution of the FOUNDATION in uplifting the weaker sections especially educationally backward people of the society. The growing popularity of the institutions subjugated by the FOUNDATION is the prima-facie evidence of the success of our vision and mission. A brief sketch of the activities emitted by the FOUNDATION for educational upliftment & social welfare is as following.

1. National Festivals:- The celebration of the National Festivals is too necessary for creating the feeling of patriotism among people especially students. that is why the FOUNDATION has celebrated the national festivals i.e. Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti & Republic Day with great pomp & show. The students had great zeal & interest for these festivals. The National flag was heisted by the persons of great reputations and eminence on these festivals. Several debates and other cultural programmes were held by the FOUNDATION and these occasions.

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 65,231/-** on National Festivals.

2. Health Camp:- Being encouraged by the previous activities & output of the health camps, the FOUNDATION decided to organize a large Health Camp on 12.02.2017 on Sunday for the awareness among people for several disease. This one like the previous was also very successful for the point of the Social Service. In this 3 specialists took part and more than 610 patients were checked and medicines also distributed among people. Thus the FOUNDATION proved again that it is quite helpful to general weal of the public. This is also the motive of the whole Managing Body. This Health Camp was widely appreciated by the people for it contained quite the sober wishes of charity.

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 91,917/-** on this camp.

3. Handicapped Welfare Camp :- In present time the condition of the handicapped people is very humble in spite of a lot of Govt. Scheme, the handicapped are still forced to lead a harsh & even in human life. Sometime the outlook of their own family is also very negative & harassing. The mostly handicapped are coupelled to adopt the Foundation decided to organize a camp for the awareness among the handicapped people. The chief purpose of this camp was to explain the Govt. schemes for the welfare of the handicapped. This camp was held on 22.01.2017. on Sunday. The experts narrate a lot of schemes to handicapped. It was also highly appreciated & successful.

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 39,805/-** on it.

4. Blindness Awareness Camp :- In present time the Blindness among people is very common in spite of a lot of Govt. Scheme, the Bind people are still forced to lead a harsh & even in human life. Sometime the outlook of their own family is also very negative & harassing. The mostly Blind people are compelled to adopt the Profession of begging. So the Foundation decided to organize a camp for the awareness among the Blind people. The chief purpose of this camp was to explain the Govt. schemes for the welfare of the Blind. This camp was held on 04.09.2016. on Sunday. The experts narrate a lot of schemes to handicapped. It was also highly appreciated & successful.

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 40,278/-** on it.

5. Leprosy Awareness Camp :- Leprosy Awareness Camp, as we know that the Leprosy is burning question of our society. Keeping in mind that there is not so much awareness among people about the Leprosy which is a fatal disease that causes a lot of loss of Life. That is why the foundation decided to hold a camp for the awareness among people about Leprosy. This camp was widely appreciated by the people and they took part in it with the great zeal. A lot of patients of leprosy were checked in this camp. This camp was held on 11.12.2016 Sunday.

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 40,505/-** on it.

6. Old Person Welfare Camp :- The condition of old Person is still very pitiful in our society. Though the Govt. is running several schemes & plans for the welfare of the old persons i.e. senior citizens yet there is not any remarkable change in their conditions. We know that it is our cultural heritage to respect & obey elderly persons. But due to the western influence we are neglecting our old persons as they are burden and unnecessary things in our life. Keeping in mind the importance of old persons in our society the Foundation held a camp for the welfare of old persons on 20.11.2016 Sunday to give them the information of different Govt. schemes & plans, the lectures were delivered. This camp proved very helpful to the old persons. Everybody liked it very much.

The Foundation spent **Rs. 40,321/-** on this camp.

7. Plantation Promotion Camp :- The plantation has become very important for the well being of human life. The environmental changes & many other problems many be solved by the proper plantation. Thus the people impressed by the idea & advantages of plantation. This camp proved very successful in its aim. People looked willing to plant the tree after hearing the lectures.

The Foundation spent **Rs. 38,485/-** on this camp.

8. Pulse Polio Camps:- The FOUNDATION has a firm purpose of social welfare in this course FOUNDATION has participated actively in organizing the Polio Camps in library premise on every Polio Sundays. The first & foremost objective of the FOUNDATION is to assist in activation of the Govt. schemes & plans for social welfare & development. These camps were held on every booth day i.e. 16th April 16, 29th May 16, 25th September 16, 29th January 17. Many tiny kids up to the age of 5 years got vaccinated very properly.

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 11,147/-** on these camps.

9. Political Awareness Camp :- We know India is a democracy & here the political Parties have great importance in National Politics. Keeping in mind the role & significance of Political Parties & to create the awareness among the people about the political affaire of the country the Foundation organized a camp for political awareness among common people. This camp was held on 16th October 2016. This camp was very unique & people liked it very much. A lot of common people & political workers took part in it. It left a deep impression upon the people. This camp succeeded in its very aim. People became aware of their political rights. It also created curiosity about the national & state politics. People admired this camp very much.

The Foundation spent **Rs. 39,884/-** on this camp.

10. Pollution Awareness Camp :- The present condition of our environment is very polluted. We know that there is a lot of air, water and noise pollution in our atmosphere. Though there are many scheme and programs to remove the pollution but there is no success. Thinking the worst condition of pollution The Foundation decided to hold an Awareness camp. In fact Foundation wants to create a sense of awareness among people about the pollution. This camp was held on 19.06.2016 on Sunday. Through this camp The Foundation conveyed a message of awareness for pollution

The FOUNDATION spent **Rs. 40,083/-** on it.

Other Institutions Run By The Foundation

Amroha Public Library:- The Amroha Public Library is first and foremost institution of the FOUNDATION. It was established for increasing the knowledge and hobby of reading books. It was established in April 2000. It has more than **23674** books and magazines and journals on a lot of subjects. All these books and periodicals cost about **Rs. 25,02,908/-** The Library has proved a great social work for the city. It has been utilized and appreciated by every kind of people very widely. The growing numbers of readers everyday is the prime facy evidence for its popularity.

Eureka Vocational Institute :- Having kept in mind the enlistment & development of women especially the girls. The FOUNDATION has established Eureka Vocational Institute. This one proved a grand success in the way of making the women self depend. In the second step of Eureka Vocational Institute about **35** courses were provided and about **265** trainees got training in this institute and it proved very supportive for them for 10 months.

Eureka Computer Education:- As the Computer has become the need of the time so it is also considered to spread and impart the computer education to the students for their self dependence. The FOUNDATION is running a computer center named Eureka Computer Education. This year **40** students both boys & girls were imparted training and computer skill. Now they are self-depend and working for their living. The FOUNDATION is much satisfied with their progress.

Eureka Vocational Center (B):- Having considered the importance of Calligraphy in Urdu to the way of self employment, the FOUNDATION has started a training centre for Urdu calligraphy to impart sharp skill and keen knowledge of the rules of Urdu Calligraphy. This one was also hailed highly by the Urdu-speaking students and about **60** students (both boys & girls) were imparted training. The Calligraphy Centre was also admired by a lot of people of city because the FOUNDATION has tried to revive this ancient tradition of writing Urdu in stylish manner.

IAR-ITI:- As India needs a huge number of skilled professionals in future, the Managing Committee had decided to establish an ITI in the city. The main objective is to develop industrial training program in various trades. We want to prepare a work force of skilled professionals for the future. With a lot of hard work and efforts of Managing Committee and Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Imam Ahmed Raza Industrial Training Institute is being established in Amroha. The Foundation has arranged 1.5 acres of land on lease for the tenure of 29 years. For construction of building of ITI, a grant of Rs. 10,00,000 was sanctioned by Maulana Azad Education Foundation & Rs. 7,00,000 has been received till now. Construction of building is in full swing and supposed to be completed and start functioning shortly. The foundation is determined to upgrade this ITI to a Technical Degree College in near future.

Eureka Coaching Centre:- Eureka Coaching Centre which is registered under the coaching registration act, 2002 through the office of DIOS, Amroha whose registration number is JPN – 0074. The FOUNDATION got the renewal of this registration on 10th December 2008 for the next three years. This center has been established with the sole purpose of helping the poor & needy students through books. The best sitting arrangement, regular session and computerized notes are the salient features of this coaching centre. Eureka Coaching Centre has been very popular among the students for the graded guidance and high educational atmosphere. The FOUNDATION further aims at starting the coaching for the major entrance exams as I.A.S., I.P.S., P.C.S., IIT, JEE, CPMT, AIEEE, MAT, and many more.

Eureka Book Bank:- Eureka Book Bank is a subordinate institute of Amroha Public Library. The FOUNDATION provides the books to the brilliant & needy students for the whole year. Through this Book Bank a lot of students have benefited till now. Eureka Book Bank contains all the important & necessary books of various subjects like Literature, Psychology, Urdu, Education, Economics, Geography and Commerce. The FOUNDATION aims at the spread and progress of education among the people especially backward classes and Scheduled caste. This Book Bank also provides the journals and other important magazines to the students for the preparation of the competitive exams.
